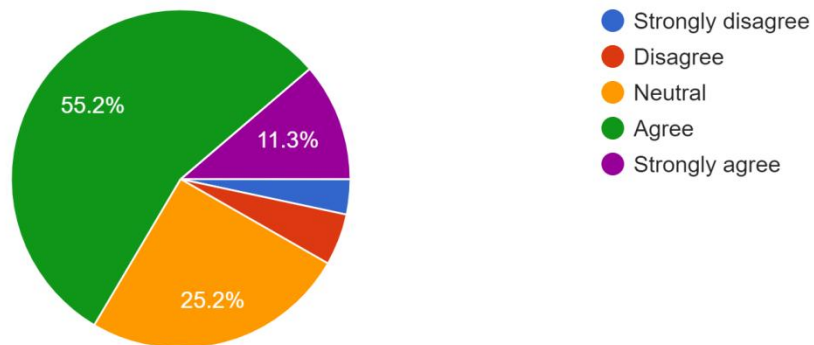
### **Analysis report based on the survey and suggestions:**

The feedback received from students regarding the curriculum has been overwhelmingly positive, with many praising the existing curriculum. They have expressed satisfaction with the comprehensive and well-structured course offerings, which have provided them with a strong foundation in their respective fields of study. The syllabus is often commended for being up-to-date, relevant, and aligning with industry demands, preparing students to face real-world challenges with confidence. In addition to the appreciation for the existing curriculum, a prevalent suggestion among the students is the incorporation of new add-on courses. They believe that introducing specialized courses, such as workshops, seminars, and skill-based training, would further enrich their learning experience. These add-on courses could focus on emerging technologies, interdisciplinary subjects, and practical applications, enhancing their knowledge and employability prospects. Moreover, students have emphasized the significance of co-curricular activities. They believe that engaging in such activities alongside academic studies fosters holistic development. Suggestions include organizing more workshops, guest lectures, and events that promote creativity, leadership, and teamwork. By offering a diverse range of co-curricular opportunities, students feel that they can cultivate essential soft skills, gain exposure to different perspectives, and build a well-rounded personality.

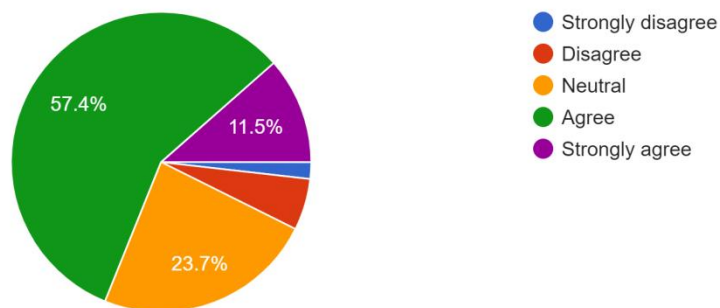
The academic syllabus was significant and updated.

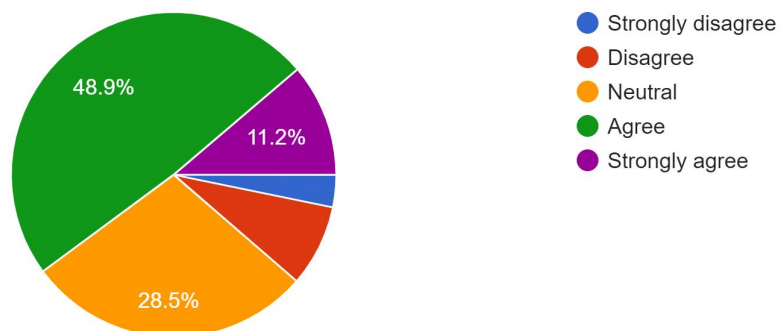
The learning objectives of each course in the syllabus are well defined and clear.

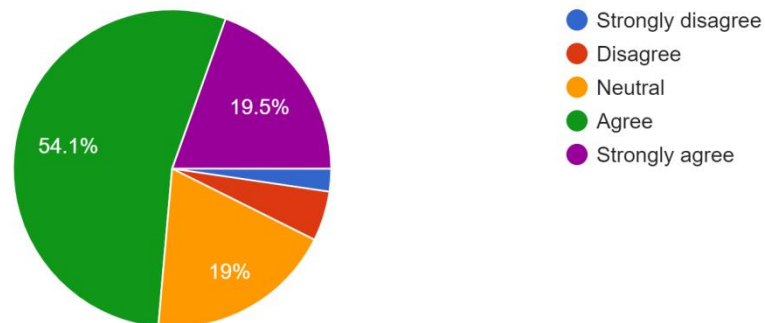
The syllabus is appropriate for the programme and includes the recent advancements in the subject.

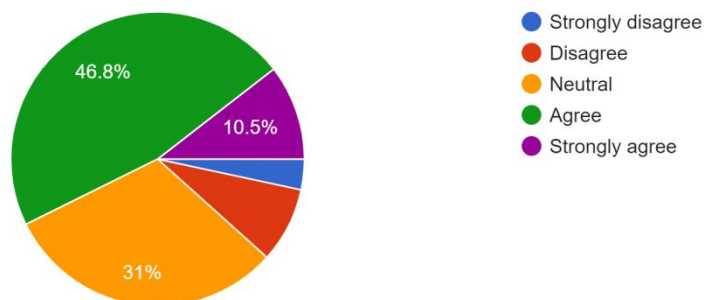
The recommended textbooks/references and other learning resources are available.

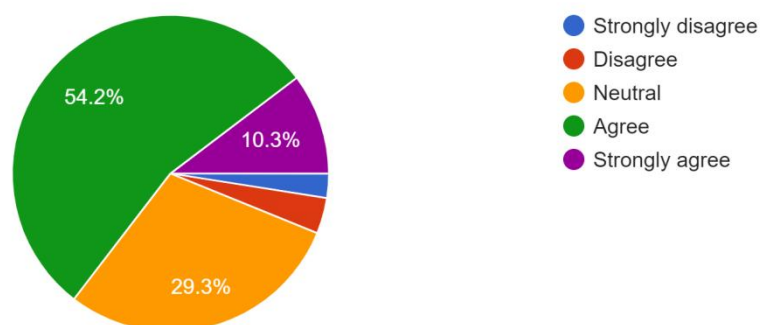
The curriculum designed for the programme encourages extra learning/self learning.

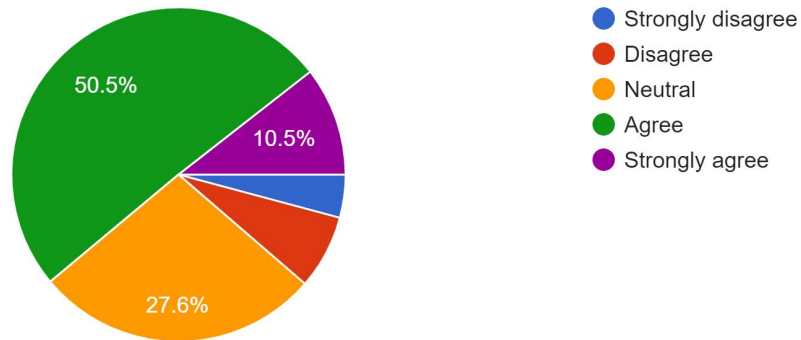
The electives offered are relevant to the core subject and are useful for the specialisation of a subject domain.

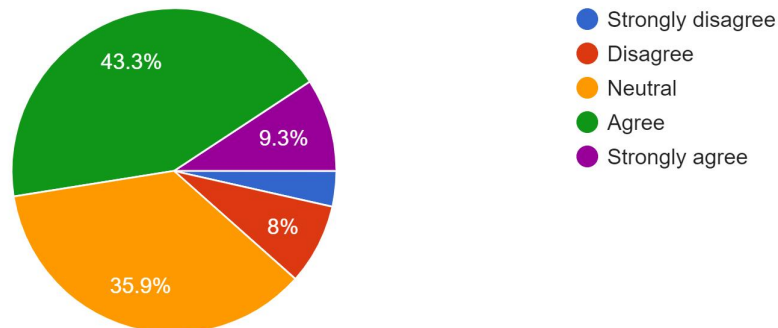
The curriculum introduces students to issues such as gender equality, environment and sustainability, ethics and other values.

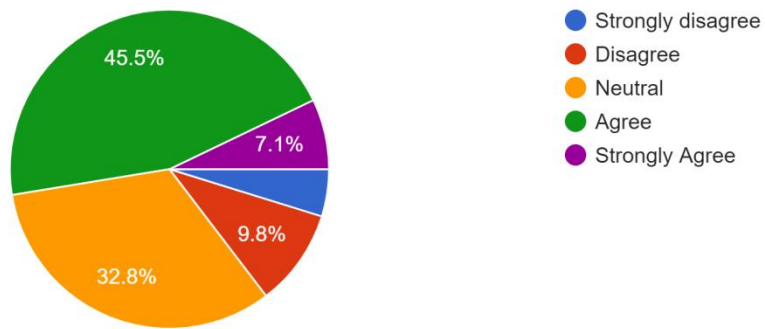
\*The laboratory experiments are designed to enhance the understanding of the concepts and promote experimental learning.
