Student Curriculum Feedback Report 2022-23


The student curriculum feedback survey, conducted online, gathered responses from 837 students. The survey comprised nine questions covering various aspects of the curriculum of the college. Respondents were asked to rate specific items using a 5-level scale, with options ranging from "Poor" to "Excellent."

Analysis report based on the survey and suggestions:


- Students have recommended the introduction of additional value-added and certificate courses that enable them to align with industry requirements and acquire supplementary knowledge.
- Certain students have requested remedial classes or sections aimed at enhancing their academic performance and addressing any pending coursework or back papers.
- Some students have shown a keen interest in organizing venues for the exhibition and discussion of entrepreneurial ideas. They have suggested conducting workshops to explore the potential of startups.
- A group of first-year students voiced their concerns regarding the transition from a school-level syllabus to a university-level curriculum.

Below is a graphical representation of the student responses to each question.


The academic syllabus was significant and updated. 832 responses




The learning objectives of each course in the syllabus are well defined and clear. 833 responses




The syllabus is appropriate for the programme and includes the recent advancements in the subject. 831 responses



The recommended textbooks/references and other learning resources are available. 832 responses




The curriculum designed for the programme encourages extra learning/self learning. 831 responses




The electives offered are relevant to the core subject and are useful for the specialisation of a subject domain.


The curriculum introduces students to issues such as gender equality, environment and sustainability, ethics and other values.




*The laboratory experiments are designed to enhance the understanding of the concepts and promote experimental learning.
