Teacher Curriculum Feedback Report 2022-23


The teachers curriculum feedback survey, conducted online, gathered responses from 331 teachers. The survey comprised eight questions covering various aspects of the curriculum of the college. Respondents were asked to rate specific items using a 5-level scale, with options ranging from "Poor" to "Excellent."

Analysis report based on the survey and suggestions:


- ❖ Teachers at our college have conveyed their apprehensions and uncertainties concerning the implementation of the New Education Policy (NEP). They recommended organizing programs to prepare for the effective implementation of this new policy.
- While several teachers emphasized the need for improvements in the college's lab facilities, the overall feedback from educators was positive, particularly regarding the curriculum. Teachers commended the curriculum's strengths and suggested enhancements in specific areas, including the lab facilities, to further enhance the educational experience.
- Teachers recommended to organize workshops and training programs focusing on the research aspects that can help the PhD scholars and faculty members of the college.

The curriculum is designed based on the needs of the stakeholders. 67 responses




The learning objectives of each course in the curriculum are well defined and clear. 69 responses




The sequence of the courses in the curriculum and the organisation of the content in different courses are appropriate.


The allocation of the credits to the courses is appropriate with regard to the level of coursework required




The electives offered are pertinent to the core subject and helpful in specialising in a functional area of the subject domain.




The curriculum sufficiently motivates both the teachers and students for further study and research. 69 responses




The syllabus is competitive and at par with the syllabi of the other institutions/ syllabus proposed by UGC for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).
