
Teachers' Curriculum Feedback Report 2021-22


Analysis of the Report


Below is a graphical representation of the student responses to each question.



The curriculum is designed based on the needs of the stakeholders. 68 responses




The learning objectives of each course in the curriculum are well defined and clear. 68 responses




The sequence of the courses in the curriculum and the organisation of the content in different courses are appropriate.


The allocation of the credits to the courses is appropriate with regard to the level of coursework required




The electives offered are pertinent to the core subject and helpful in specialising in a functional area of the subject domain.




The curriculum sufficiently motivates both the teachers and students for further study and research. 68 responses




The syllabus is competitive and at par with the syllabi of the other institutions/ syllabus proposed by UGC for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).
